

## LA FIDUCIE DU PATRIMOINE CULTUREL DES AUGUSTINES PRESENTS ITS BOARD OF DIRECTORS

**Quebec, May 28, 2013** – La Fiducie du patrimoine culturel des Augustines presents its Board of Directors. The Fiducie can now count on the leadership of 11 Board members, as well as management, to carry out its strategic plans and reach its objectives.

In addition to ensuring the successful completion of this important step in the restoration of one of Old Quebec's heritage sites – a building that the Augustinian Sisters transferred to the Fiducie for the benefit of the entire population - the Board's mandate is to: define the vision for the various components of the project, establish policies, approve budgets, ensure the integrity of administrative and organizational processes, and assure sustainability.
